

HOW TO ASSEMBLE TABLE AND FLOOR LAMPS

- 1 Squeeze the two pronged open end of the harp into the harp saddle (two prongs below the lamp socket). Slide the small metal caps on the harp down.
- 2 Unscrew the metal washer from the top of the harp, put aside.
- 3 Place shade onto the top of the harp.
- 4 Screw the washer onto the harp. (The washer that was previously put aside.)
- 5 Screw on the pewter finial. NOTE: When handling the finial it is best to hold the finial at the base. The pewter can be bent if not handled properly.
- 6 Adjust the shade so that it is level.
- 7 The pull chain should hang on the left or right side of the lamp stem. The power cord should be running out the back of the base.



HOW TO PROPERLY TIGHTEN A LOOSE BASE

PLEASE INSPECT ALL LAMP BASES FOR LOOSENESS which can occur during shipping. All of our table and floor lamps can be tightened by holding the socket firmly in a stationary position. **DO NOT TURN THE SOCKET TO TIGHTEN.** As you hold the socket tight-
en the hexnut on the underside of the stone base with a set of pliers. If a floor lamp needs to be tightened this should be done with two people. One holding the socket firmly so that it does not spin and the other should tighten the hex nut on the underside of the base.
